DUNBAR RFC v KENMORE;- This match took place at Dunbar, on Saturday. Kenmore opened strongly, and were soon in the home "25". Shortly afterwards however, the visitors threes, by good handling, obtained a try, which was not converted. In the second half Dunbar improved and C.M Burton was almost through. The ball was not going into the scrum well, and once after five or six attempts at doing so by the opposing scrum-halves, the referee put it in himself. The home forwards were now playing a better game, but Kenmore held out strongly and with only a few minutes to go, it looked as if they were going to gain a narrow win. On time, however, M.L Gibbs "sold the dummy" to his opponent and scored a brilliant try. J.S Allport brought out full points. On the whole, Dunbar were rather lucky to win.
