Immediately after Gibbs put Dunbar further ahead, D Sharpe missing an easy kick.

On the resumption, Dunbar again attacked, and crossed the Revenue line twice but were recalled because of infringements. Good forward play led to Dunbar scoring through Brown. No goal resulted. Revenue attacked and scored near the corner, the try being converted.
