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Scottish Rugby launches new Covid-19 e-learning course

Scottish Rugby has launched a new Covid-19 E-Learning Course in line with Stage 3 Return to Rugby guidelines. This free course, available [here](#), aims to develop people's understanding of Scottish Rugby's Return to Rugby Roadmap and key public health advice in line with the Scottish Government guidelines.

All coaches and match officials must complete the course before taking part in any Return to Rugby activity and will form part of the minimum operating standards for 2020-21. It is also recommended for players, parents and volunteers.

Covid-19 Safety Coordinators (now in place at over 120 clubs) will coordinate the completion of the course by all coaches (all age groups) before activity resumes. No formal compliance exercise will be undertaken by Scottish Rugby at this stage.

The course takes approximately 30 minutes to complete and is accessible on all internet enabled devices, including smart phones and tablets.
